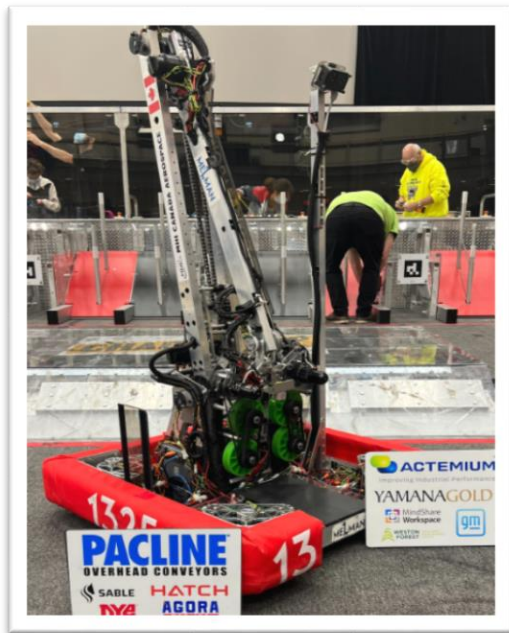

Who We Are

Established in 2004, FIRST Robotics Competition Team 1325 Inverse Paradox is a community robotics team for middle and high school students located in Mississauga, Ontario. We are a registered charity with the Canada Revenue Agency. The team participates in the FIRST Robotics Competition (FRC) and the FIRST Lego League (FLL) Challenge, annual robotics challenges designed to foster innovation in science and technology in students. Our team consists of 40 students from grades 9 to 12 working together to build a 120-pound industrial strength robot, and 10 grade 7 and 8 students building robots using the Lego Mindstorm system. Students work together to encourage the community to participate in STEM related activities by hosting workshops and presenting to all age groups.

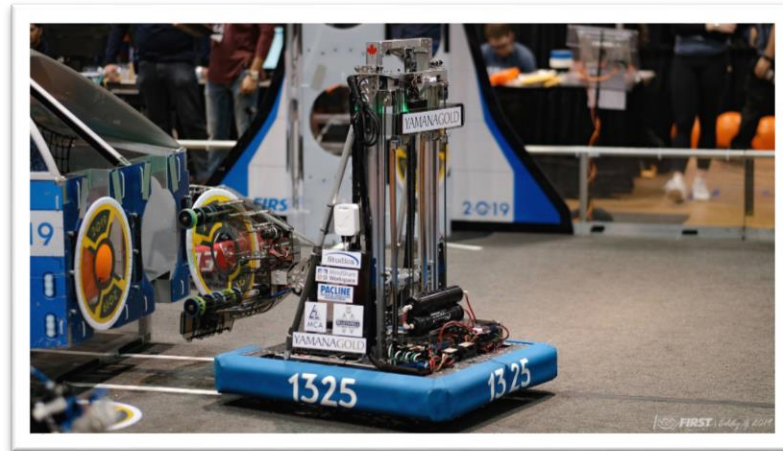
